### **School of Fine Arts special admission program**

Admission to programs in the School of Fine Arts (SFA)—architecture, art, art education, graphic design, interior design, music, music education, music performance, and theatre—is restricted upon entry (that is, not all first-year students who apply for admission will be accepted specifically for their intended major).

Students pursuing SFA majors will need to follow two distinct processes.

First, the student must submit Miami's complete application for admission.

Second, by the application deadline and with the appropriate department, the student will need to submit a portfolio for architecture, art, art education, graphic design, interior design; schedule an audition for music, music education, music performance; or schedule an audition/interview for theatre.

No student's application for one of the above majors in the School of Fine Arts is complete until the portfolio or audition/interview has been completed. All departmental scholarships are awarded on the basis of portfolios and auditions/interviews.

If a student is applying for Early Decision notification, the application for admission and the portfolio submission/audition scheduling must be completed by Nov. 1, 2009. Most Early Decision notifications are made by the Office of Admission prior to the School of Fine Arts notifications regarding admission into a specific program.

Students admitted to Miami University but not to their intended program in the School of Fine Arts will be accepted as "undeclared" students and may attempt entry to the major again after their first-year. Early Decision applicants not admitted to their intended SFA program will be released from their contractual agreement to attend Miami.
