RE: Managing Important Safety or Wellness-Related Issues on the Regionals

As chairs of Miami University's Institutional Response Team (IRT), we wish to provide you with a reminder of how we handle various critical incidents on campus. An informed campus can produce a more prompt, efficient and effective response. In addition to this notice, you should have already received a small card with campus-wide emergency numbers.

Below we briefly outline various protocols:

- For imminent emergencies on the regional campuses always call 911 and consult with campus security as follows: Hamilton 785-3222, Middletown 727-3333, and VOALC 895-8862 or 780-8862
- Concerns about students in distress can be submitted to the regional Office of Student Affairs by calling the Regional Associate Dean of Students (785-3128 Hamilton or 727-3326 Middletown) during business hours or 24/7 by going online to the online Student of Concern Management System, at <http://www.miami.muohio.edu/studentconcern> or for an urgent situation, calling the MUPD dispatcher at (529.2222) and leaving a message for the Dean of Students
- To receive text messages about campus-wide emergencies, sign up for the **Miami Emergency Text Messaging system** via the MUPD website, <http://www.muohio.edu/police/>
- **Disruptive Classroom Behavior:** Call campus security for serious disruptions, and consult with the Regional Office of Student Affairs-MUH, MUM, VOALC for non-threatening but significant disruptions
- Notices about **ill students, student deaths or student personal incidents** will come from the Regional Office of Student Affairs-MUH, MUM, VOALC
- Presentations about how to intervene and assist with student mental health or wellness issues via the **Campus Assistance Program (CAP)** can be requested by contacting **Student Counseling Services** (529-4634)
