

The Miami University Rowing Club has been found responsible for violating the Code of Student Conduct, Section 105B (Prohibited use of alcohol).

In September 2011, it was reported to the University that the Rowing Club held an event where alcohol was available to minors. During a meeting, officers of the club acknowledged that the event occurred.

The following is the mandatory sanction imposed upon the organization by the University:

- The members of the Rowing Club must complete an alcohol education course with 80% of their members and 100% of the most recent new member class attending.
